## Notes to the Statement of standalone financial result:

- 1. The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board of Directors in the meeting held on 14th February, 2022 and approved by the Board of Directors in the meeting held on the same day.
- 2. The statutory auditors of the Company have carried out the limited review of the financial results for the quarter and nine month ended 31st December 2021 as required under Regulation 52 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- 3. The Company adopted Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) notified under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 (the Act) read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 from 1st April 2021 and the effective date of such transition is April 1, 2020. Such transition have been carried out from the erstwhile Accounting Standards notified under the Act, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and guidelines issued by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) (Collectively referred to as "the Previous GAAP). The figures have been presented in accordance with the format prescribed for financial statements for NON- Banking Finance Company (NBFC) whose financial statements are drawn up in compliance of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 in Division III of the Notification No GSR 1022(E) dated 11th October, 2018, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India. The comparative figures for the nine month ended 31st December 2020 and for the year ended 31st March 2021 have been restated by the Management as per Ind AS but have not been subject to limited review or audit. However, the Management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the financial results provide a true and fair view of the Company's affairs. - 1.
